sum of fifty dollars, and provided further that no additional compensation shall be allowed as aforesaid, compensation when the appearance fees allowed, by law, to said State's Attorney, amount to or exceed, in any year, the sum of nine hundred dollars, nor when such additional compensation, together with said fees, will exceed the sum of eight hundred dollars.

Additional -

- SEC. 3. Be it enacted, That the State's Attorney for Charles county shall in no case receive fee or Not receive compensation when he is not personally present, or unless present represented by other counsel acting in the trial of such case.
- SEC. 4. Be it enacted, That the several fees and allowances provided by the preceding sections, to be paid to the State's Attorney, shall be due and pay-When due able to him in current money by the County Com- and payable. missioners at their first meeting held after the adjournment of the respective terms of court at which the services were rendered.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
