

CHAPTER 146.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to borrow the sum of forty thousand dollars, and to provide for the payment of the same out of the levy for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight and for eighteen hundred and seventy-nine. Whereas the County Commissioners of Baltimore county have ascertained that the taxes levied for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven have been for the most part collected and expended, and that there exists a large indebtedness against the county, created by their predecessors in office, for which immediate provisions must be made; therefore,

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow the sum of forty thousand dollars, in addition to the sum of twenty thousand dollars heretofore borrowed under authority of law by their predecessors in office, if so much shall be found to be necessary, and to provide for the payment of the same out of the annual levy for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight and for eighteen hundred and seventy-nine.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
