 re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be lawful for the Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company to erect upon their road a toll-gate at any point on said road north of the point where the road known as the Manor road joins with the road of the Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company, and not nearer than half a mile to the town of Hagerstown; and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to remove the present toll-gate upon the north end of said road, should they at any time avail themselves of the powers and privileges contained in this act. Shall be lawful. Not nearer. Directed to remove.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company shall not charge at its toll-gate which may be located north of the point of the joining of the said Manor road with the road of the Hagerstown and Sharpsburg Turnpike Company, more than half the usual and customary rate of toll upon all travel through said gate, located as aforesaid, which turns upon the Manor road or comes from the Manor road. Shall not charge. More than half.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage, and the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter, annul or repeal this act at pleasure. In force. Reserves right.
