

CHAPTER 153.

AN ACT to prevent the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors within the distance of one-half mile from the main exhibition hall of the Agricultural and Mechanical Society of Harford county during the days of any exhibitions of said society.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That any person who shall sell or barter any spirituous or fermented liquor or liquors, lager beer or cider, within the distance of one-half mile from the main exhibition hall of Agricultural and Mechanical Society of Harford county on the days of any exhibitions of said society, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than fifty nor more than two hundred dollars, or shall be imprisoned in the county jail not less than ten nor more than thirty days, in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That if any person shall while selling or bartering any article whatsoever, give any spirituous or fermented liquor or liquors, or lager beer or cider, such giving of any of said liquors shall be construed a sale within the provisions of preceding section.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted,* That if any person shall commit an offence against the provisions of the preceding sections, such person shall, in addition to the penalties therein mentioned, forfeit all such spirituous and fermented liquors, and all the chests and other things containing the same belonging to or in the possession of the person so offending; and it shall be the duty of any sheriff, deputy sheriff or constable, or any of the special police to be appointed as hereinafter provided, if he or they shall see any person violating the preceding sections, to arrest the offender and carry him before a justice of the peace, who shall hold him to bail, and in default thereof shall commit him to jail to await the action of the next grand jury. The sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable or special police aforesaid, when he arrests the offender, shall seize the property hereby declared
