Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That there Appointed shall be appointed annually some competent person annually. to act as bridge keeper, whose duty it shall be to attend to the opening and closing of the draw of said bridge so purchased or built when required, and also to attend to such other duties in regard to keeping said bridge in safe and proper condition for public Bridgekeeper travel; and the said bridge keeper shall receive for his services such compensation as the said Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county shall think just and proper, to be provided for in their annual Shall be made levy, which appointment shall be made the first year, and on the first day of April every second year thereafter, by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, and on the first day of April in every alternate year by the County Commissioners of Anne Arunel county.
