## CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT to repeal sections eighty-seven and ninety of article ten, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "County Commissioners," enacted by the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter four hundred and forty-nine, and all other sections or parts of sections of the Code of Public General Laws and Public Local Laws, and all other acts and sections, or parts of acts or sections, of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland inconsistent with the provisions of this act, and to enact the following in lieu thereof:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections eighty-seven and ninety of article ten, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "County Commissioners," enacted by the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter four hundred and forty-nine, and all other sections or parts of sections of the Code of Public General Repealed and Laws and Public Local Laws, and all other acts and enacted in sections, or parts of acts or sections of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following are enacted in lieu thereof:

Five commissioner districts.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That Dorchester county be and is hereby divided into five commissioner districts, as follows: Commissioner district number one shall be composed of the first (or Fork) and twelfth (or Williamsburg) election districts; commissioner district number two shall be composed of the second (or East New Market), third (or Vienna) and eleventh (or Drawbridge) election districts; commissioner district number three shall be composed of the seventh (or Cambridge), eighth (or Neck) and thirteenth (or Bucktown) election districts; commissioner district number four shall be composed of the fourth
