or (Parsons Creek), sixth or (Hoopers Island), and ninth or (Church Creek) election districts; and commissioner district number five, shall be composed of the fifth or (Lakes), and tenth or (Straits) election districts of said county.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That at the next general election for county officers in Dorchester county, there shall be five county commissioners elected for ers to be electsaid county, one of whom shall have charge of each ed. commissioner district, whose duties shall be as are now and may herein and hereinafter be prescribed by law.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the Governor of Maryland, immediately upon the passage of this act, appoint a treasurer for said county, who shall be styled the Treasurer of Dorchester county, and shall treasurer. hold his office from the first Monday in May, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, to the first Monday of May, eighteen hundred and eighty, and until his successor is duly appointed and qualified, and whose duty it shall be to receive and disburse all moneys levied and collected for county purposes, according moneys levto the order of the County Commissioners of said county, and to receive from the several collectors for said county and pay over to the Treasurer of Maryland, as hereinafter directed, all moneys levied and collected for the said State in said county; he shall keep a separate account of both State and Keep separ. county levies with each collector, and shall make ate accounts. and keep a duplicate of each and every receipt given for all public moneys received by him; he shall make quarterly returns of the amounts of moneys received by him to the County Commissioners of said county, and monthly returns to the Comptroller of the Treasury respectively; he shall also serve and act as clerk to said County Commissioners, Act as clerk. and as such it shall be his duty to record the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners, and to perform all such other duties as are now or may hereinafter be prescribed by law for the clerk of said board; he shall keep the office of said commissioners open from nine o'clock A. M. until three o'clock opening. P. M. each week day; he shall have charge of all records, books, &c., of said commissioner's office, and shall not allow any of them to be removed or taken
