CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of a sum of money to Henry Asquith, for professional services rendered the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer for the payment to Henry Asquith, of the sum of three hundred dollars, for compensation for the trial of the case of William A. Thompson *versus* Levin Woolford, Comptroller, in the Circuit Court of Anne Arundel county, and in the Court of Appeals; and the trial of the case of the County School Commissioners of Prince George's county *versus* Levin Woolford, Comptroller, in the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county, which said sum of three hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for that purpose.
