Commissioners per diem and mileage. SEC. 80. The said Commissioners shall receive four dollars per day each for every day they shall necessarily attend to the duties of their office, and five cents per mile for each mile each way they may have to travel to their place of meeting.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 169.

AN ACT to continue the corporate existence of the President, Directors and Company of the Hagerstown Bank.

Corporate exist'nce continued. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the President, Directors and Company of the Hagerstown Bank be and they are hereby continued in existence as a body politic and corporate under its name aforesaid, from the time when according to existing laws the said corporation would expire, until the first day of January, in the year one thousand nine hundred and ten, and until the end of the regular session of the General Assembly next thereafter ; provided, however, that the said corporation is continued upon the conditions and subject to the limitations in this act contained, and the said corporation shall be and it is hereby made subject, from and after the time when it would expire in pursuance of existing laws, to the several provisions and articles herein contained.
