

CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and ninety-four of the Code of Public Local Laws, article two, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Sheriff," as the same was repealed and re-enacted by the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter one hundred and six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and ninety-four, article two, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Sheriff," as the same was repealed and re-enacted by the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter one hundred and six, entitled "An act to repeal section one hundred and ninety-four of article two of the Public Local Laws," entitled "Anne Arundel county," sub-title "Sheriff," and to re-enact the same with amendments, relating to the fees of sheriffs for keeping and boarding prisoners, be repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 194. The sheriff of Anne Arundel county shall be allowed for keeping and boarding each prisoner committed to the jail of said county the sum of forty cents per day, to be levied and collected according to law. Sheriff's allowance for boarding prisoners.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the expiration of the term for which the present sheriff was elected. In force.
