

two," and to re-enact the same with amendments, be and is hereby repealed, and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows, viz.:

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That in the county of Garrett, in the Fourth Judicial Circuit, the next term of the Circuit Court to which jurors shall be summoned for the said county shall commence on the first Monday of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, instead of the third Monday of March as heretofore; and thereafter the regular law terms of said court, to which jurors shall be summoned, shall commence on the second Monday of September and the first Monday of May in each and every year, and that hereafter there shall be held two other law terms of said court, to which jurors shall not be summoned, commencing on the first Monday of July and the third Monday of December in each year, and there shall be held in said county on the third Monday of March, eighteen hundred and seventy eight, and not thereafter, a law term of said court, to which jurors shall not be summoned for the transaction of such business as may be transacted without the presence of grand and petit jurors, and at which bonds and recognizances which shall have been taken for the appearance of parties at said March term may be renewed or respited until the next succeeding July term in all cases in which it may be necessary or proper so to do.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to repeal section nine hundred and forty-six, article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, volume two, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Witnesses," and to re-enact the said section with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section nine hundred and forty-
