

than one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the county jail not less than ten nor more than forty days, in the discretion of the court, and his or her license shall thereupon be suppressed.

Suppressed for violation. 7. Whenever any license shall be suppressed for any violation of this act, it shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cecil county to grant a license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer to any other person for the remainder of the term for which said premises have been rented to sell as aforesaid upon the premises for which the license has been so suppressed.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to add additional sections to article eighty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," and to repeal all laws inconsistent with the provisions of said sections.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That additional sections be and the same are hereby added to article eighty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," to read as follows :

Tax Commissioner. SEC. 149. There shall be in the Treasury Department a Tax Commissioner of the State of Maryland, to be appointed by the Governor, Comptroller and Treasurer, or a majority of them, who shall take the Oath. oath prescribed by the constitution, and shall hold his office for four years from the date of his qualification and until the appointment and qualification of his successor, and shall receive a salary of twenty-five Receive a salary. hundred dollars per annum and such necessary trav-
