trict number fourteen as by law they are now authorized respectively to appoint for the other election districts of said county, and the County Commissioners aforesaid shall do whatever else within the scope of their power may be necessary to effect the object of this bill.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of May, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Allegany county to exchange a certain portion of the land belonging to said county, known as the Alms House Farm, and to receive in exchange therefor another piece of land from William T. Mullen, and to receive and hold the said land so exchanged.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Commission of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Allegany county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to exchange a certain small portion of the land belonging to said county, known as the Alms House Farm, with William T. Mullen, for other lands, to be by him deeded to them, and to receive and hold the same for the said county, for the same uses and purposes as those under which the original grant is held.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That in order to ena-Proper deed. ble the said County Commissioners to make a proper deed for said lands, the president of said County Commissioners be and he is hereby empowered for and on behalf of all said commissioners to execute and acknowledge said deed in the same manner and
