

the County Commissioners, together with the total of the fees received, shall not amount to more than one thousand dollars in any one year, and in no event shall the State's Attorney receive more than one appearance fee in the same case.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all laws and parts of laws inconsistent with this act are hereby re-
pealed. Repealed.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take
effect from the date of its passage. In force

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to authorize the commissioners of the town of Cambridge, Dorchester county, to purchase or condemn a lot and to erect thereon a fire engine house and a market house.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of the town of Cambridge be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to purchase or to condemn a lot in some central locality in the town of Cambridge, and to erect thereon a fire engine house or a market house, or both fire engine and market house. Authorized and empowered.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That if the said commissioners shall condemn said lot, they shall proceed according to article ten of sections fifty-five, fifty-six and fifty-seven of the Maryland Code, Public Local Laws. Condemn lot.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That before proceeding to erect an engine house or market house, the said town commissioners shall publish proposals therefor, with specifications, in the Cambridge newspapers for not less than three weeks, and let out the contract for such building to the lowest responsible bidder, but the cost in no event to exceed fifteen hundred dollars. Publish proposals. Lowest responsible bidder.
