

**Benefit of all laws.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said district, Dames' Quarter, number two, shall be entitled to the benefit of all laws which are now applicable and in force in said district, and the said laws are by this act declared to be in force from the time this act shall pass until repealed by the General Assembly of Maryland.

**Place of elections.** SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the place of holding elections in said Dames' Quarter District shall be fixed by the County Commissioners in as central a place, somewhere in the vicinity of Smith's or Walker's Store, "St. Peter's," that being about as central as any suitable place can be obtained for the purpose holding elections.

**Governor shall appoint.** SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the Governor shall appoint one justice of the peace and one register of voters for the said Dames' Quarter District, number two, and the County Commissioners shall appoint one constable for said district.

**Furnish suitable book.** SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county shall furnish a suitable book for registration, such as may be required by law, to be delivered to the register of voters in said Dames' Quarter District, number two, and the register of said district shall register therein all persons qualified by law to vote in said district in alphabetical order, and the register of said Tangier District shall register all the resident voters in that part of the annexed district in the registration book of said district, and all other qualified voters residing therein who shall make application to be registered, having the legal qualifications.

**Duty of registration officer** And it shall be the duty of the officer of registration for said Princess Anne District to erase from the list of qualified voters on the registration book thereof the names of all persons residing within the limits of that portion of Princess Anne District, number one, which has been cut off and annexed to Dames' Quarter District from the aforesaid Princess Anne District.

**Local laws continued.** SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That all local laws now in force in said district are continued in force, and
