make sale.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That said justice of the peace shall be fully authorized to make sale of such stock if not returned as aforesaid, and out of all monies arising from such sale made under the execution of this act he shall pay to the party taking up and impounding said stock one dollar for each of said stock for his services therein, and also all other expenses incurred, including fifty cents per day for each of said stock for the keeping thereof, and the remainder to the owner or owners who may establish claim to said property, and in the event of no such claimant appearing within thirty days thereafter then the balance aforesaid shall be paid into the school fund for Baltimore county.

CHAPTER 188.

AN ACT giving the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Delilah West, deceased, late of Dorchester county, to the Joppa Methodist Episcopal Church South, or its trustees, at Tobaccostick, Dorchester county, Maryland.

Bequest sanc-
tioned.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the bequest of the residue of her estate after the payment of her debts and certain legacies therein mentioned, in the last will and testament of Delilah West, deceased, to Joppa Methodist Episcopal Church South, at Tobaccostick, Dorchester county, Maryland.
