

CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT to authorize the appointment of an additional justice of the peace for Caroline county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That in addition to the justices of the peace in the third election district of Caroline county as now provided by law there shall be an additional justice of the peace appointed for said district in Caroline county, who shall be a resident of the town of Denton. Additional Justice.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.

 CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners for Talbot county to purchase Miles River Bridge, and to make the same a free bridge.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners for Talbot county be and they are hereby authorized to appoint two suitable persons to examine and report upon the condition of Miles River Bridge in said county, who shall make to said commissioners an appraisalment, under oath, of said bridge; and said County Commissioners are further authorized, in their discretion, to purchase said bridge of the Miles River Bridge Company, at the amount of the appraisalment returned to them as aforesaid; provided, the amount thereof does not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars. Appoint persons to examine.
Authorized to purchase.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That said County Commissioners are authorized to levy on the taxable property of said county as other levies are Authorized to levy.
