SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the said town commissioners be and they are hereby authorized to assess and levy upon the tax payers of said town such sum of money as is necessary to give effect to and carry out the provisions of this act, not to exceed, as aforesaid, fifteen hundred dollars; provided not more than one-half the requisite amount shall be levied in any one year.

In force SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to repeal section thirteen of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled, "Allegany County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section thirteen of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

SEC. 13. They shall meet on the first Monday of January, second Monday of April, first Thursday of July, and second Monday of October in each year, and may call special meetings whenever they, or a majority of them, may think proper.
