## CHAPTER 195.

AN ACT to consolidate the Baltimore, Hampden and Towsontown Railroad Company, incorporated by the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed in eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter three hundred and fourteen, under the name of the Baltimore and Swann Lake Passenger Railroad Company, as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and seventy-two, and the Baltimore, Towsontown, Dulaney's Valley and Delta Narrow Guage Railway Company, as incorporated under the provisions of the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter four hundred and seventy-six, with powers to construct, manage and operate a railway from the city of Baltimore, through Baltimore and Harford counties, to a point on the Pennsylvania line near Delta.

Corporations consolidate.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Baltimore, Hampden and Towsontown Railroad Company, incorporated by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter three hundred and fourteen, under the name of the Baltimore and Swann Lake Passenger Railway Comauthorized to pany, as amended by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter two hundred and seventy-two, and the Baltimore, Towsontown, Dulaney's Valley and Delta Narrow Guage Railway Company, as incorporated under the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter four hundred and seventy-six, the charter of which was recorded in the office of the Secretary of State at Annapolis, on the twentysecond day of March, eighteen hundred and seventysix, be and they are hereby authorized to consolidate themselves into a single corporation, to be known as the Baltimore and Delta Railway Company, which consolidation shall be made in the manner follow-
