CHAPTER 218.

AN ACT to repeal sections one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-one, twentytwo, twenty-three, twenty-four, twenty-five, and twenty-six, of article eighteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's county," sub-title "Almshouse," and enact a substitute therefor.

Repeal.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two, twentythree, twenty-four, twenty-five, and twenty-six, of article eighteen Code Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's county," sub-title "Almshouse," be and the same are hereby repealed and the following sections enacted in lieu thereof:

Sec. 2. The almshouse in St. Mary's county and Control of the property thereto attached shall be under the exalmshouse. clusive management and control of the County Commissioners of said county.

with tenant.

Sec. 3. The said County Commissioners shall annually, at their first regular meeting in June, or as soon thereafter as practicable, let said almshouse and other property to such person as they may deem fit, Contract and at the same time shall contract with said tenant, who shall be styled the keeper of the almshouse, upon such terms and conditions as they may deem reasonable and proper for the maintenance and support of the inmates of said almshouse for the period of one year, commencing from the first day of January thereafter.

Sec. 4. Any one of said commissioners may, in How admitwriting, direct the admission of any poor person to said almshouse.
