

CHAPTER 220.

AN ACT changing the place of voting in the third election district of Kent county, Maryland, from "Worten Heights," or "Hanesville," to Smithville, in said election district.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the place of voting in the third election district of Kent county, Maryland, be and is hereby changed from "Worten Heights," or "Hanesville," to Smithville in said election district. Election district changed

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

 CHAPTER 222.

AN ACT to amend the charter and enlarge the powers of the "American Coal Company of Allegany county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the "American Coal Company of Allegany County," organized under an act to authorize the formation of corporations for mining purposes, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-two, chapter three hundred and twenty-two, be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase and hold such amount of the capital stock and first mortgage bonds of any railroad corporation which now owns or may hereafter acquire, or construct a railroad leading from any convenient point at or near its mines in Allegany county to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, or to the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad, or to both of said works, or to any point in Allegany county, as the president and directors of said corporation, or a Empowered to purchase and hold capital stock.
