majority of them, may deem expedient, and the same to use, possess, enjoy and control, with all the other rights and privileges of any other owner or holder of such stock.

In force.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 223.

AN ACT to enable the Comptroller of the Treasury to adjust and settle the claim of Daniel A. McCoy for bounty due him under chapter fifteen, section one, of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

Preamble.

Whereas by reason of inability to file his claim for said bounty before the first day of September, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, as provided by chapter two hundred and thirty-five, section six, acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and sixtyeight, he has been deprived of the just amount due him; therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to adjust and just and settle the claim of Daniel A. McCoy, private company L, First Regiment B. H. B. Maryland Volunteers, as due him by chapter fifteen, section one, acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-four.

In force.
