all places of business in their respective districts, which lists shall contain the name or names of persons doing business at each place, the character of business, the date of the license and the name therein; and in all cases of conviction for selling in said county without a license the constable informing against the Informer's person so convicted shall receive the informer's portion of the fine imposed; each constable appointed by the Commissioners as inspector of licenses shall receive from said County Commissioners a fee of ten cents for each license inspected by them.
