

## CHAPTER 228.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of Thomas C. Basshor and Company, and Joseph Thomas and Sons, for work done and material furnished at the State Normal School.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer for the sum of two thousand and thirty-seven dollars and sixty-six cents, in favor of Thomas C. Basshor and Company for work done and material furnished at the State Normal School, and also in favor of Joseph Thomas and Sons, for two thousand two hundred and thirty-three dollars and forty-two cents, for work done and material furnished at the State Normal School.

Comptroller directed to issue warrants.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

## CHAPTER 229.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments the eighth section of the thirty-eighth article of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the eighth section of the thirty-eighth article of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

8. Each clerk and Register of Wills on coming into office, shall complete all the unfinished business
