

provided, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Governor shall appoint by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, one superintendent of said lines of telegraph authorized by this act, who shall supervise the construction of the same and the operation of the said lines when the same are constructed. The said lines of telegraph shall be worked at no other cost to this State than the cost of repairing said lines of telegraph and maintaining their efficiency, except the salary of the superintendent of said lines of telegraph, which shall be fifteen hundred dollars a year. Governor shall appoint one superintendent.
Worked at no other cost.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force

CHAPTER 233.

AN ACT to repeal an act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and fifty-one, entitled "an act to refund to the executor or administrator of Samuel H. Birkhead, deceased, late collector of the first district of Harford county, a sum of money erroneously paid into the treasury."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and fifty-one, entitled "an act to refund to the executor or administrator of Samuel H. Birkhead, deceased, late collector of the first district of Harford county, a sum of money Act repealed.
