erroneously paid into the treasury," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Comptroller directed to re-

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to refund to the executor or administrator of Samuel H. Birckhead, deceased, late collector of taxes of the first district of Harford county, the sum of eighty-nine dollars and seventy cents, being for this sum erroneously paid into the treasury by him, as appears by the certificate of the County Commissioners of Harford county, and the recommendation of the officers of the Treasury Department of the State.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 234.

AN ACT to repeal chapter four hundred and thirtynine of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to regulate the issuing of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in this State," and to re-enact the same, with amendments, so as to exempt Montgomery county from the provisions of said act.

Repealed and re-enacted. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter four hundred and thirty-nine of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to regulate the issuing of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in this State," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
