

directed to pay to the order of the board of trustees of Western Maryland College the sum of twenty-six hundred dollars annually, on and after the first day of June, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, for and during the term of two years.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer, on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the said board of trustees of Western Maryland College the sum of five thousand two hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly, to be applied by them in furnishing board, fuel, lights and washing to one student to be educated free of charge for tuition from each Senatorial District of this State, and appointed by the School Commissioners in said Senatorial District, by and with the advice and consent of the Senator in their respective Senatorial Districts, after a competitive examination of the candidates; provided, that the said appointment shall not be held by the same student for more than four years, and that each student receiving such appointment, shall give his bond to the State of Maryland for such amount with such security as may be approved of by the president of said College, that he will teach school within this State for not less than two years after leaving College.

Treasurer directed to pay.

One student from each senatorial district

Shall not be held.

That he will teach.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 240.

AN ACT to enable the County Commissioners of Washington county to protect its interests as creditor of and guarantor for the Western Maryland Railroad Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Washington county be and they are hereby authorized to purchase bonds.
