CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to incorporate the Salisbury Market House Company of the town of Salisbury, in Wicomico county.

*SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That William J. Leonard, Milton A. Parsons, Ebenezer L. Wailes, Samuel H. Fooks, Alexander G. Toadvine, Elihu J. Pusey, Thomas Humphreys, John Tracy, George H. W. Ruark, William S. Parsons, Charles F. Holland, George Waller, Henry W. Anderson, Benjamin H. Parker and James Cannon be and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, with perpetual succession to them and their successors, under the name and style of the Salisbury Market House Company, and by said name shall sue and be sued, and perform all other acts and things in pursuance of the purposes of their incorporation that may be done and performed by a natural person.

Corporation created.

Name and style.

Corporation authorized to adopt seal, by-laws, &c.

Authoriz'd to issue capital stock, &c.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said corporation are hereby authorized and empowered to adopt a common seal for the use of the same, and to change and alter it at will, and also to make and adopt a constitution and by-laws, or system of rules and regulations for the government and management of the affairs of the said corporation, and to change and amend the same whenever circumstances may require it.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said corporation be and they are hereby authorized to issue cap-
