Required to keep up index
 Authoriz'd to demand fee.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That from and after the passage of this act the Register of Wills of Charles county is hereby required to provide for and keep up a general index to all wills, bonds, guardian accounts, administration's accounts, inventories, accounts of sales and releases that may hereafter be deposited in said office for record, and he is hereby authorized to demand and receive from any person or persons depositing the same the sum of ten cents for the special purpose of keeping up and continuing said general index in said office.

In force.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 253.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact sections one, two and nine of chapter one hundred and fifty-one of the acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Newtown, in Worcester county."

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections one, two and nine of chapter one hundred and fifty-one, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, of the General Assembly of this State, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Newtown, in Worcester county," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the town of Newtown, in Worcester county of this State, shall, from
