

and privileges of the Mayor, except to sign ordinances, and all meetings of the Council shall be public.

Appoint clerk. SEC. 11. *And be it enacted,* That the Mayor and Councilmen shall appoint and qualify a clerk, who shall keep minutes of their proceedings, which shall be subject to the inspection of all persons interested therein, and perform all other duties pertaining to the office; also a treasurer, who shall give bond and security, and pay moneys only on the order of the Mayor and Council.

Compensat'n for services. SEC. 13. *And be it enacted,* That they may allow their clerk, treasurer, bailiff and police such reasonable compensation for their services as they may think proper, and have the power to dismiss each or any of them at pleasure, and in ascertaining the pay of the bailiff, they may allow him such reasonable percentage on all taxes collected and paid over to the treasurer as to them may seem just, and the Mayor shall receive one hundred dollars per annum, and each Councilman one and one-half dollars per day for each day they may be in session or attending to their public duties.

Pay of Mayor and Councilmen.

Pass ordinances beneficial to the town. SEC. 14. *And be it enacted,* That the Mayor and Councilmen may pass such ordinances, not contrary to law, as they may deem beneficial to the town; they shall have power to remove nuisances and obstructions from the streets, lanes and alleys, and from any lots adjoining thereto, and also any houses or other buildings that may become dangerous to the neighborhood on any account, and to provide for the organization, equipment and government of fire companies, and enforce such rules and regulations as they may think necessary to preserve the public health and secure the inhabitants from contagious, infectious or other diseases, suppress drunkenness, vice and immorality, and punish all violations of the public peace from whatever cause, and generally they shall have power to ordain and enforce all ordinances, rules and regulations necessary for the peace, good order, health and safety of the town and of the people and property therein, and may impose such reasonable fines, forfeitures or imprisonments as to
