

CHAPTER 269.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to Charlotte Hall School, in St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of one thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the use and benefit of Charlotte Hall School, and that said appropriation shall continue for five consecutive years.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That said sum of one thousand dollars be and is hereby made payable by the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller, to the president of the trustees of Charlotte Hall School, on the first day of June, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, for five consecutive years from the date thereof, and no longer.

CHAPTER 270.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Brokers."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an additional sub-section be added to section seventeen, article fifty-six, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Brokers," to read as follows :

SEC. 17. SUB-SEC. 2. If any individual, co-partnership or firm shall use or exercise the business or occupation of a merchandize broker, without having procured a license as required by law, he shall be subject to a penalty of five hundred dollars for each offence, one half thereof for the use of the State and the other half to the informer.
