be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Fees of notaries public.

SEC. 21. Notaries Public shall be entitled to demand and receive the following fees, to wit: protesting any note, draft, bill of exchange or check, for non-acceptance or non-payment, two dollars; for drawing all proceedings not exceeding two sides, fifty cents; for drawing all proceedings exceeding two sides, per side, twenty-five cents; for registering or copying proceedings, for every side, ten cents; for presenting a bill of exchange for acceptance, if accepted and not afterwards protested for non-payment, one dollar; for noting a bill for non-acceptance, if not protested for non-acceptance or non-payment, one dollar; for noting a marine protest, one dollar; for affixing notaries' seal, fifty cents; for every search where no copy is made, twenty-five cents; for administering an oath or taking an acknowledgment, twelve-and-a-half cents; for all other acts and service, in proportion to the aforesaid fees, to be paid at the time of doing the same. For going any distance more than three miles from his residence, per mile, twenty cents; for every notice of protest mailed or delivered, five cents; for presentation and demand for payment of a promissory note, a bill of exchange, if payment of same be made to the notary, one dollar.

In force.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
