

CHAPTER 286.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty, article twenty-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Roads," as re-enacted with amendments by chapter four hundred and twenty-three, laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, so far as the same relates to Baltimore county, and to prevent public roads from passing through burial grounds.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty, of article twenty-eight, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Roads," as re-enacted with amendments by the Legislature of Maryland at its January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and twenty-three, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as it relates to Baltimore county; and no public road shall be opened or altered so as to pass through any burial ground without the consent of the owners thereof in writing. Consent of owners necessary.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall in force take effect from the date of its passage.
