Farquhar the sum of thirty-six dollars and ninety-five cents, being the amount erroneously paid by said Sarah B. Farquhar to said county for county taxes from the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven to the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six inclusive.

CHAPTER 288.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to provide station houses or lock-ups in portions of the county adjacent to the city of Baltimore.

Buildings for persons arrested.

Make necessary regulations.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to erect or to rent suitable buildings, not exceeding three in number, to be located on the northern, eastern and western suburbs of Baltimore city, to be used for the temporary detention of persons who may be arrested by the county police or committed by justices of the peace; provided the cost of said buildings, if erected, shall not exceed the sum of fifteen hundred dollars each; and the County Commissioners are authorized to make such regulations for the keeping of said station houses, for the detention of persons therein, and for their removal to the county jail, as may be necessary and proper.

In force.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
