

CHAPTER 289.

AN ACT to regulate the fees of the State's Attorney for St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Saint Mary's county, may, in their discretion, allow the State's Attorney for Saint Mary's county additional compensation; provided, that no additional compensation shall be allowed when the total appearance fees allowed by law to said State's Attorney amount or exceed in any one year the sum of one thousand dollars; and, provided, further, that this act shall not be so construed as to include the fees and commissions of the said State's Attorney allowed and paid by the State of Maryland. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the State's Attorney of Saint Mary's county shall not receive any fee in cases of recognizance except when the same are traversed; nor shall said State's Attorney receive any fee or compensation in any case, except he be present personally, or represented by other counsel acting in the trial of such case. Not receive fees.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 290.

AN ACT to regulate the price to be paid for the county printing of St. Mary's county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county shall, before their levy term in each year, contract with the editors and proprietors of a newspaper published in said county and having Contract for printing.
