

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT to create a new election district in Somerset county, and comprising all that territory belonging to the State of Maryland on Smith's Islands.

Election district number ten. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new election district be laid out of Crisfield District, number seven, in Somerset county, the said district to be known and called by the name of Smith's Island District, or election district number ten.

New election district. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said new election district shall comprise all that territory belonging to the State of Maryland on Smith's Islands.

Place of holding election. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the place of holding the election in said new district shall be upon the Island, at the place where it was usually held prior to the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter forty-three, which changed the place of holding the election from Smith's Island to the main land, and within the corporate limits of the town of Crisfield.

Governor shall appoint. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the Governor shall appoint two justices of the peace for the said district from persons resident upon the Island, and one registrar of voters for the said new district, which said registrar shall be a resident of the Island, and at the time of sitting for the purpose of correcting the registration books and registering new voters, who shall be entitled to registration, shall hold such sittings at the usual place of holding elections in said district.

Rights and privileges. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That the inhabitants of said new election district number ten shall be entitled in all respects to all the rights and privileges held or enjoyed by the other election districts in said county of Somerset, and to the benefit of all local laws now in force in Crisfield district number seven.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county shall furnish a
