

said county, a full and particular account of the amounts received by them respectively for the repair of their respective portions of said road, and also of the various items of expenditures upon the same, accompanied by the vouchers for the said expenditures, and for the performance of their duties under this act the said superintendents shall severally be allowed, as an item of said expenditures, the sum of two dollars per day for each and every day which they may be actually engaged in making said repairs, improvements and expenditures.

CHAPTER 292.

AN ACT to permit the shooting of wild fowl from sink boxes in the waters of the Elk and Bohemia Rivers and their tributaries in Cecil county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That on and after the passage of this act, it shall be lawful for the *bona fide* citizens of Cecil county to shoot wild fowl from sink boxes in the waters of the Elk and Bohemia Rivers and their tributaries in said county, from the first day of November in each year until the thirty-first day of March next succeeding, on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday of each week, upon obtaining a license so to do as provided in section two of this act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Cecil county shall, upon the application of any *bona fide* resident of Cecil county, being the owner of any sink box, and desiring to
