

proper book for registration, such as may be required by law, to be delivered to the registrar of voters for said Smith's Island district, and the said Clerk shall also, at the same time, deliver to the said registrar a full list, under the seal of his office, of all persons appearing on the registration lists of said Crisfield district; and the said registrar of voters for said Smith's Island district shall transcribe from said lists of voters, and enter in alphabetical order in the said new registration book the names of all voters living within the limits of and entitled to vote in said new district number ten; and likewise to register therein the names of all persons who shall become entitled to vote in said district according to the laws of this State.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the officer of registration for Crisfield district, when the books of registration shall be given him by said Clerk, shall strike from the lists of qualified voters of said Crisfield district the names of all persons residing within the limits of said Smith's Island district number ten and entitled to vote within that district.

Strike from lists.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to repeal section three hundred and ten of article eleven of the Public Local Laws, entitled "Frederick county," as re-enacted by chapter seventy-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, and to re-enact said section so as to read as follows:
