SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 303.

AN ACT to repeal section thirty-six of article fifteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Montgomery county," sub-title "Jurors," as the same was repealed and re-enacted by the acts of 1876, chapter 187.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section thirty-six of article fifteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Mont-gomery county," sub-title "Jurors," as the same was re enacted. repealed and re-enacted by the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter one hundred and eighty-seven, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 36. The County Commissioners of Montgomery county shall annually levy such sum of money as they may deem sufficient to pay the expenses which may be incurred the then succeeding year by to pay jurors, the attendance of jurors, State's witnesses, criers and bailiffs at the Circuit Court, and shall apportion and place the same in the hands of the collectors of the several election districts in which it is to be collected, for collection, and the amounts, when collected, shall be paid over to the collector of the fourth election district, to be by him disbursed as hereinafter provided, and any of said collectors failing to pay over to the said collector of the fourth election district one half of the amount so levied and placed in their failing to pay hands, on or before the first day of November, and over. one half on or before the first day of March, succeeding the levy as aforesaid, shall, for any such failure, forfeit and pay to the collector of said fourth
