four, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 310. The Sheriff of Frederick county shall Fee allowed. be entitled to twenty-five cents per day for boarding each prisoner committed to the county jail.

In force.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the entrance of the Sheriff of Frederick county, to be elected at the November election, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, upon the duties of his office.

## CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to refund to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore a sum of money paid by the said Mayor and City Council for the removal of the walls and debries from the burnt tobacco warehouses Nos. one and two.

Preamble.

Whereas, by article forty-three, section eighty-eight of the ordinances of the city of Baltimore, the City Commissioner is authorized to remove any wall or building which is dangerous to persons or property at the expense of the owners of the same; and whereas the walls and debries removed were in a condition dangerous to persons and property; therefore,

draw warrant

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is Comptroller hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant authorized to upon the Treasurer in favor of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the sum of two hundred and forty-five dollars, the sum expended by the said Mayor and City Council for the said removal of walls and debries from tobacco warehouses Nos. one and two.

In force.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
