

CHAPTER 305.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claims of James S. Watkins, John Brohawn and John Kelly.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby requested and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to James S. Watkins one hundred dollars for insurance license erroneously paid by him for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-seven; to John Brohorn, six dollars and two cents, for money overpaid by him into the State Treasury in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five; to John Kelly, fifteen dollars and twenty-eight cents, for damages to the pungy "Two Brothers," caused by the Oyster Police sloop "Nannie Merryman." Claims to be paid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall In force. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 306.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of John Murphy & Co.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby requested and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to John Murphy & Co. five hundred and forty-six dollars, for copies of the State Constitution, Codes and Supplements for the Senate and House of Delegates. Claim to be paid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
