AN ACT to refund taxes on oyster house, ordinary and retail liquor traders' licenses, to Jacob Williams, Charles W. Bennett, William T. Elliott, Edmund W. Norris, Henry Nichols, Owen A. Boon, Joseph Rasin, John B. Todd and Son, James E. Cahal, James T. Robinson, Amelia Wright, administratrix of Joseph V. B. Wright, J. R. Colescott, Levi Howeth, Mary Fountain, E. C. Godwin, S. P. Jump, T. L. Hopkins, Dennis L. Council, William B. Ewing, C. M. Lloyd, Daniel C. Barnett and Philemon Mullikin, of Talbot county, erroneously paid to the State.

Preamble.

Whereas by an act of January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter one hundred and ninety-seven, certain persons included in the body of said act not being named in the title thereof are not entitled to the provisions of said act; now, in order to carry out the purposes of said act, therefore,

Refund ordinary licenses erroneously paid.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That, on the warrant of the Comptroller, the Treasurer is hereby directed to pay to Jacob Williams, of Talbot county, the sum of seventy-three dollars and ninety-six cents, for taxes on oyster house licenses, and to Charles W. Bennett, of said county, the sum of sixty-seven dollars and fifty cents, for taxes on ordinary licenses, and to William T. Elliott, Edmund M. Norris, Henry Nichols, Owen A. Boon, Joseph Rasin, John B. Todd and Son, James E. Cahal, James T. Robinson, Amelia Wright, administratrix of Joseph V. B. Wright, deceased, J. R. Colescott, Levi Howeth, Mary Fountain, E. C. Godwin, S. P. Jump, T. L. Hopkins and Dennis L. Council, of said county, each the sum of thirteen dollars and fifty cents, for retail liquor traders' licenses, and to William B. Ewing, C. M. Lloyd, Daniel C. Barnett and Philemon Mullikin, of said county, each the sum of eighteen dollars and seven-
