SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the rooms of the Stock and Real Estate Exchange of the city of Baltimore shall be known and designated as the Exchange Salesrooms of the city of Baltimore, to be used as public salesrooms for real estate and other property ordered to be sold at the Exchange Salesrooms by auction or otherwise.

CHAPTER 310.

AN ACT to refund to Rebecca G. Gelston and Isaac D. Jones, administrators c. t. a. of Hugh Gelston, Roxanna Marden, executrix of Jesse Marden, Henry Brown and Hamilton Easter, certain taxes erroneously paid by them.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed and requested to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to Rebecca G. Gelston and Isaac D. Jones, administrators c. t. a. of Hugh Gelston, the sum of two hundred and twenty-five dollars, being the amount of collateral tax paid by them into the Treasury upon a devise of real estate in trust, which devise has since been adjudged and decreed to be null and void; to pay to Roxanna Marden, executrix of Jesse Marden, the sum of forty-four dollars and eighteen cents, being the amount of tax erroneously paid into the Treasury by said Jesse Marden in his life time; to pay to Henry Brown the sum of ninety-six dollars, being the amount of license erroneously paid by him from eighteen hundred and sixty-eight to eighteen hun-
