

May grant diplomas. in its various schools, and to grant diplomas to such as, after proper examination, may be found worthy of the distinction.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State of Maryland be and he is hereby directed to pay annually to the President of the Institute, in the month of April, the sum of three thousand dollars, which shall be used in behalf of its various schools of learning and educational departments, and shall not be diverted therefrom for any purpose whatever.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the President of the Institute shall, annually, in the month of September, make a detailed report of the operations of the schools of art and design, and other educational departments, to the Governor of the State of Maryland.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That said corporation shall not issue any note, token or scrip, to circulate as currency.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 314.

AN ACT to repeal the second section of the Act of General Assembly, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter four hundred and three, entitled "An act to provide for the indexing the records in the office of the Register of Wills for Allegany county," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
