

CHAPTER 317.

AN ACT to establish two voting precincts in the eighth election district of Baltimore county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That hereafter the eighth election district of Baltimore county shall be divided into two voting precincts.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That the Surveyor of Baltimore county shall lay off said precincts in the following manner: Beginning at a point in the centre of Baltimore and Yorktown turnpike, opposite the public road leading into the village of Texas, thence following said road to railroad at Texas, thence by straight line to centre of road at a point opposite William Park's dwelling, thence in a line due west to a point where the eighth and fourth election districts join, then reversing and marking said line to place of beginning; from thence by a line due east to a point where the eighth and tenth election districts join, then reversing and marking said line to the beginning.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted,* That that portion of the eighth election district north of said line shall be known as the first precinct, and that the voting place shall be at Cockeysville; and that that portion of the eighth election district south of said line shall be known as the second precinct, and that the voting place shall be at or near the railroad station at Timonium.

SEC. 4. *Be it enacted,* That the Surveyor of Baltimore county shall report, upon conclusion of this work, to the County Commissioners of Baltimore county, in writing, designating the dwellings and names of occupant within fifty yards of said line on either side, and should said line go through any dwelling, the said surveyor shall state in said report upon which side of said line the larger portion of said dwelling shall be located, and the occupants of said dwelling entitled to vote shall vote in the precinct where the larger portion of their dwelling is located.
