Duty of re-
turn judge.

SEC. 11. *Be it enacted*, That the judge designated by the County Commissioners of Baltimore county as return judge, shall, upon the votes having been counted in each of said precincts, and certified there- to by said judges, or a majority of them, the said re- turn judge shall take possession of said certified re- turns, ballots and Registration List, and return the same to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Balti- more county, at his office, in the court-house at Towson town.

Duty of Clerk
of Circuit
Court.

SEC. 12. *Be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Baltimore county, immediately after the next election in said county, to have prepared two registration books for the eighth election district. In one there shall be re- corded a list of the name of each citizen who voted at the first precinct, and in the other the name of each citizen who voted at the second precinct of the eighth election district, and in addition thereto in each registration book the names of all registered voters who did not vote at the election held next after the passage of this act.

SEC. 13. *And be it further enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
