

## CHAPTER 319.

AN ACT to appoint an additional justice of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for Harford county, and in the fourth election district of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an additional justice of the peace shall be appointed by the Governor of this State in the manner now provided by law for the appointment of justices of the peace in the State in and for the fourth election district of Harford county.

 CHAPTER 320.

AN ACT to repeal section ninety-nine of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Manufacturers and Miners," and to re-enact said section with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section ninety-nine of article one of the Code of Public Laws, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Manufacturers and Miners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :
