

Blind, for the Education of Deaf and Dumb and Blind Colored Children of this State, eight thousand five hundred dollars, provided the said institution shall be removed from its present site on Broadway; to the Lying in Hospital for Indigent Women, three thousand dollars; to the House of Refuge, fifteen thousand dollars; to the House of Reformation and Instruction for Colored Children, eight thousand dollars; to the Maryland Institute for the Promotion of the Mechanic Arts, as provided by act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, chapter one hundred and ninety-eight, and the proposed extension of its charter, three thousand dollars; to the Managers of the Maryland Hospital for the Insane, fifteen thousand dollars; to the State House of Correction, thirty thousand dollars for the support of the institution; and to two watchmen for the State House of Correction, seven hundred dollars each—fourteen hundred dollars.

## PUBLIC DEBT.

For the payment of the interest on the Public Debt of the State, including cost of exchange, remittance and commission, for so much thereof as is payable in London, six hundred and fifty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

SEC. 2 *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified to or upon the order of the person or persons, or bodies politic or corporate, severally entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.
