

## CHAPTER 336.

AN ACT to ratify the construction placed by the Notaries Public of Baltimore city upon section twenty-five of article thirty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Fees of Officers," sub-title "Notaries Public," and to authorize the refunding of any money paid into the State Treasury under a different construction of said act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to settle with all the Notaries Public of Baltimore city, who have heretofore made their returns regularly to his department, in accordance with said returns, and the construction placed in and by said returns upon section twenty-five of article thirty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby further authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer in the favor of Ed. Raine, of Baltimore city, for the sum of one hundred and forty-one dollars, paid by him into the Treasury of the State under a different construction placed by him upon said section twenty-five of article thirty-eight aforesaid, from that placed upon said section by the other Notaries Public of said city.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
