

hundred thousand dollars, upon such terms and conditions as the said Mayor and City Council may by ordinance prescribe; provided that the ordinance authorizing such subscription for said endorsement shall have been submitted to the legal voters of the city of Baltimore at such time and places as may be fixed by said ordinance, and approved by a majority of the votes cast at such time and places. That the said five hundred thousand dollars, or any part thereof, shall not be paid until the said Maryland and Delaware Ship Canal is completed. When paid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 339.

AN ACT to revive an act to incorporate the Vienna Academy in Dorchester county, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, chapter one hundred and sixty-three, entitled "An act to incorporate the Vienna Academy in Dorchester county."

Whereas the corporation of the Vienna Academy has expired by the non-use thereof; and whereas the trustees in the act creating the same, and their successors, have all departed this life : Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the said corporation be and the same is hereby revived, and the following named persons: Samuel Higgins, William S. Sherman, William S. Croft, J. W. T. Webb, James A. Higgins, Robert J. Price, and William W. Hearn, and their successors, be and the same are hereby ap- Corporation revived.
